

Open Call for Internship Opportunity

“2026 UNESCO-IISNC Internship Program”

The International Institute for the Study of Nomadic Civilizations (IISNC), under the auspices of UNESCO, welcomes applications for the **2026 IISNC Internship Program**. The primary objective of this program is to support young individuals who aspire to develop professionally in the fields of **international relations and research**, through practical internship experience and research engagement related to IISNC’s activities in safeguarding nomadic civilization heritage.

Program Outline

- **Number of Participants:** 4 students
- **Duration:** Two months (March - May 2026)
 - The duration of the program may be adjusted upon consultation with the selected participants.
 - Participants are expected to work five days per week. The schedule may be adjusted depending on individual circumstances through prior consultation.
- **Location:** Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia

Qualifications

To be eligible, applicants should:

- Be a young professional or student from Mongolia or overseas who has completed or is currently enrolled in a **Bachelor’s degree or higher** program;
- Possess a valid visa for the entire duration of the program or have no difficulty obtaining one;
- Demonstrate fluency in both spoken and written English.

Note: Selected candidates from overseas must obtain an appropriate visa depending on their nationality. Visa requirements may affect final participation in the program.

Required documents:

- Copy of university enrollment certificate or graduation certificate
- Certificate of working experience (optional for students)
- Recommendation letter (optional)

Application Procedure

Step 1: Submission of completed application form and supporting documents
(Deadline: 23 February 2026)

Step 2: Announcement of selected applicants
(27 February 2026)

Note: The schedule may be subject to change depending on circumstances.

Program Offerings

Selected participants will be offered a two-month internship at IISNC. The starting date and duration may be adjusted upon consultation.

- Participation in IISNC projects
 - Interns will gain experience working in an international environment through active IISNC projects conducted throughout the year.

Note: IISNC is not able to cover visa expenses, medical insurance, or accommodation for selected candidates.
